**Subject:** MRO Records Inspections

Dear Jay – as you know, as of today’s date, the BIA has provided you access to 26 boxes of MRO business records for a total of more than 16 business days in early October 2007, and again throughout late December 2006 and January 2007. The BIA has also provided to you, without charge, copies of thousands of pages of those records. This has required the BIA to devote significant resources to supervise the inspection, and to generate the voluminous copies you have requested.

We have now reached the point where the government must insist that you conclude your inspection. To the extent you need additional access to certain records, the BIA is willing to make arrangement for an outside service to copy and number additional documents; however, we will require MTE to pay the cost of that service. The BIA is willing to permit additional inspections on February 7 and 8 to allow you to evaluate any further copying you desire (at MTE’s expense), but that will be the conclusion of the records inspections at the MRO. I would also encourage Mr. Reynolds to make arrangements to inspect records at that time as well.
